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#### **BACKGROUND**

- The organisation currently provides training and assessment in the meat industry. Through its
  association and consultation with its client, Oakey Abattoir, it identified a need for an accredited
  program in the workplace, due to a large percentage of workers who have English as a second
  language.
- The organisation has applied to add 30832QLD Certificate III in TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) and 30833QLD Certificate IV in TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) to its scope of registration.
- The organisation has developed a partnership with Ms Sue Baker, course owner and developer of the accredited courses on this application, in order to provide accredited training to abattoir workers for the Oakey Abattoir. The partnership agreement allows for Ms Sue Baker, the course owner, and Ms Eileen Gardam as trainers and assessors for the qualifications.
- Although the organisation intends to provide training and assessment at the Oakey Abattoir, the employer will not contribute to the learning and assessment.
- The organisation was well prepared for the audit and provided rectification evidence to address noncompliances at the time of audit.

Reasons for finding of non-compliance:

• TESGRM303A Assist English as a foreign language/English as a second language learners with grammar (30832QLD)

The practical assessment was not supported by criteria defining acceptable performance for assessors and included minimal detail in the assessment instructions for students. As a result, it could not be confirmed that assessment would ensure all the requirements of the unit of competency would be addressed specifically, the required skills and the critical aspects of evidence.

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• TESCHD412A Use creative strategies to assist children to learn English (30833QLD)

The assessment tools provided did not demonstrate assessment of the critical aspect 'at least three (3) different activities must be incorporated into lessons'.

Provide assessment tools, supported by criteria defining acceptable performance for assessors and assessment instructions for students, that will ensure all the requirements of the unit of competency will be addressed, specifically the required skills and the critical aspects of evidence.

• TESCHD412A Use creative strategies to assist children to learn English (30833QLD) Provide evidence that assessment tools address all critical aspects of evidence requirements for the unit of competency.

At audit, the organisation provided amended assessment tools, supported by criteria defining acceptable performance for assessors and assessment instructions for students, which were sufficient to ensure all requirements of the unit of competency will be addressed, specifically the required skills and critical aspects of evidence.

• TESCHD412A Use creative strategies to assist children to learn English (30833QLD) At audit, the organisation provided amended assessment tools which were sufficient to address all critical aspects of evidence requirements for the unit of competency.
